"First Chinese Baptist Church, San Francisco is a multigenerational bilingual bicultural church. WHAT IS THE GOSPEL

We believe that the gospel is the good news of Jesus Christ—God's very wisdom. This good news is Christological, centering on the cross and resurrection. Consequently, the gospel is not proclaimed if Christ is not proclaimed, and the authentic Christ has not been proclaimed if His death and resurrection are not central. This good news is biblical (his death and resurrection are according to the Scriptures), theological and salvific (Christ died for our sins to reconcile us to God), historical (if the saving events did not happen our faith is worthless, we are still in our sins, and are to be pitied more than all others), apostolic (the message was entrusted to and transmitted by the apostles who were witnesses of these saving events), and personal (where it is received, believed, and held firmly, individual persons are saved).

WAB, also known as *We Are Baptist*, is one of the best ways

I have found to address the interim task of “Rethinking Denominational Linkage.” **WAB for Adults** is the final volume in a 4-book series of lessons designed to establish a foundational understanding of what it means to be Baptist.

The series includes books of lessons for younger elementary, older elementary, youth and adults. The lessons are Scripture based with each addressing a single theme about Baptist identity and beliefs.

We will be doing a church-wide, all ages study of **WAB** during the 2017 Summer Session (June 25-Aug. 13) during which we will explore the principal of Soul Freedom, why Baptists practice believer's baptism, how we approach the Bible, and evangelism among others. We pick 8 sub-topics to learn:

1. Soul Freedom (Mt 16:13-16)
2. Believers' baptism (Acts 8:26-40)
3. The Bible (2 Tim 3:14-17)
4. Evangelism (Acts 3:1-16)
5. Diversity (Acts 10:34-35; Gal 3:26-29)
6. Priesthood of all believers (Rev 1:4-6)
7. Autonomy of the local church (Acts 2:40-47)
8. Discipleship (Col 1:27-29)

They are all important and challenging topics and we expect an interesting and fruitful experience will be obtained during the series. We have invited leaders to help teach and your participation will be a great support to them.

Summer series starts from the end of June. It includes not only adults, but also youth and children. They study the same topics in Sunday School. You may discuss and share with your family members on Sunday evenings what you learned. Please pray for the spiritual renewal in families and our church.
