Kids & Youth

Well-staffed programs for Nursery, Toddlers & Elementary-age Children and younger youth will provide excellent activities for your family. Your children and younger youth will be having fun learning while you are in your sessions.

Cost

The cost is per Adult/Youth (12 and older) \$157; Child (3-11) \$92; Under 3 is free. This covers two nights, 6 meals, and unforgettable memories. For tent/RV housing, Adult/Youth is \$113 and Child is \$65. Discounts are available for families over 4 persons. This year's rates remain the same as in 2016. Scholarships are available by speaking with Pastor Visal Sok.

To keep your cost down, Saturday lunch is on your own and we'll be inviting all families to bring a snack for sharing at siu-yeh.

A Word about Costs

The actual per person cost in the Lodge/Cabins for adults/youth for the weekend is \$167 and for children is \$102. FCBC is subsidizing each person the difference of \$10 to encourage your attendance. If you are able to pay the full amount, please indicate that on the form and the church subsidy will help others come to camp. If you would like to make a contribution to Family Camp, we thank you for your gift.

What to Bring

A Bible, pen, sleeping bags or sheets & blankets, towels, toiletries, retreat clothes, a light jacket, flashlight, and lots of enthusiasm for a great weekend! Bring your favorite board games to share with others. Families with young children may want to bring an additional reading light/lamp for when your children go to sleep (the rooms have only one main, overhead light).

Things to Leave at Home

To enhance family activities at camp, the planning team recommends that scooters, skateboards and personal gaming systems stay home.

Happy Valley

What Family Camp conferees remember most are the delicious meals, home-baked breads, and cinnamon buns! Happy Valley has a swimming pool, sand volleyball, basketball, softball, hiking trails, and a children's play area.

Located in the mountains between Santa Cruz and Scotts Valley, the center is approximately 3 miles from downtown Santa Cruz that features many summer attractions. Redwoods and ferns cover most of the 30 acres. Although Happy Valley is in a semi-rural community, the atmosphere is secluded and peaceful.

Housing is in a lodge and cabins with mostly bunk beds sharing common restrooms. Bring your own sleeping bags or bedding and towels. Tenting and RV hookups are available.

Take Hwy 17 South to the end onto Ocean Street. Turn left on Water St. and then left on Market St. Stay on Market which becomes Branciforte Drive. Happy Valley is about 2 miles from Goss Ave. on the right.

From the South:

Take Hwy 1 north to Morrissey Exit. Follow the exit over the fry to Fairmount and turn right. Turn right on North Branciforte Ave., then left onto Goss. Turn right on Branciforte Drive. Happy Valley is about 2 miles on the right.
